Ext is a JavaScript library for building interactive web applications, using powerful graphical components. It was originally an extension to Yahoo's YUI JavaScript library. Ext can now be used with the Prototype and jQuery libraries, or on its own. Ext provides a number of high-quality visual components, including advanced form fields, trees, tables, menu and toolbars, tabs and dialog boxes. Everything you need for a modern website! The Ext JS 7.0 Modern toolbox supports: drag & drop, line editor and collapsible group for grids, accordion layout, form group, breadcrumb toolbar and drag & drop for tree view. A localization package has also been added to Modern Toolkit. Material Theme is now available for the Classic Toolkit. In addition, Ext JS 7.0 has been updated to support SVG-based Font Awesome 5+. The course will use the latest stable version of the project, [Ext JS 7.3](#).
