Presentation

Palo Alto Panorama™ is useful in network security management, simplifying management tasks while providing comprehensive controls and in-depth visibility of network-wide traffic and security threats.

The 2-day Palo Alto Networks® Panorama course (EDU-220), led by a certified instructor, will enable you to configure and manage the Panorama "next generation" management server, experiment with the configuration of templates and device groups, experiment with administration, log retrieval, log management and reporting, familiarize yourself with Panorama's high availability and learn about new features such as Panorama in the public cloud, the Logging Service, and GlobalProtect Cloud.

For this and all other training courses, we'll be using the latest version of the tool, Palo Alto 10.1.

Objectives

- Configure and manage a Palo Alto Networks® Panorama management server
- understand the role of the Panorama management server in managing and securing their entire network
- Know how to use combined reports to get a holistic view of the entire Palo Alto Networks ® new-generation firewalls.

- Students must have taken the Firewall 10 course on Firewall Essentials (EDU-210), have a good understanding of how to configure Palo Alto Networks next-generation firewalls.
