Divi 4 is one of the most powerful site builders for WordPress. Economical and productive, in this DIVI training course you'll discover all the subtleties of this theme manager and fabulous web page builder.

WordPress is the most widely used CMS in the world: nearly 33% of all websites are built using WordPress. This highly versatile tool can be used to create a simple showcase site or blog, as well as complex websites such as an online store, forum or LMS (e-learning platform).

WordPress certainly owes its popularity to its incredible community, always on hand to help and create new features in the form of extensions.

Although WordPress is intuitive and easy to use, there are many subtleties you need to know to improve your ranking in search results by optimizing the code used internally, for example.
